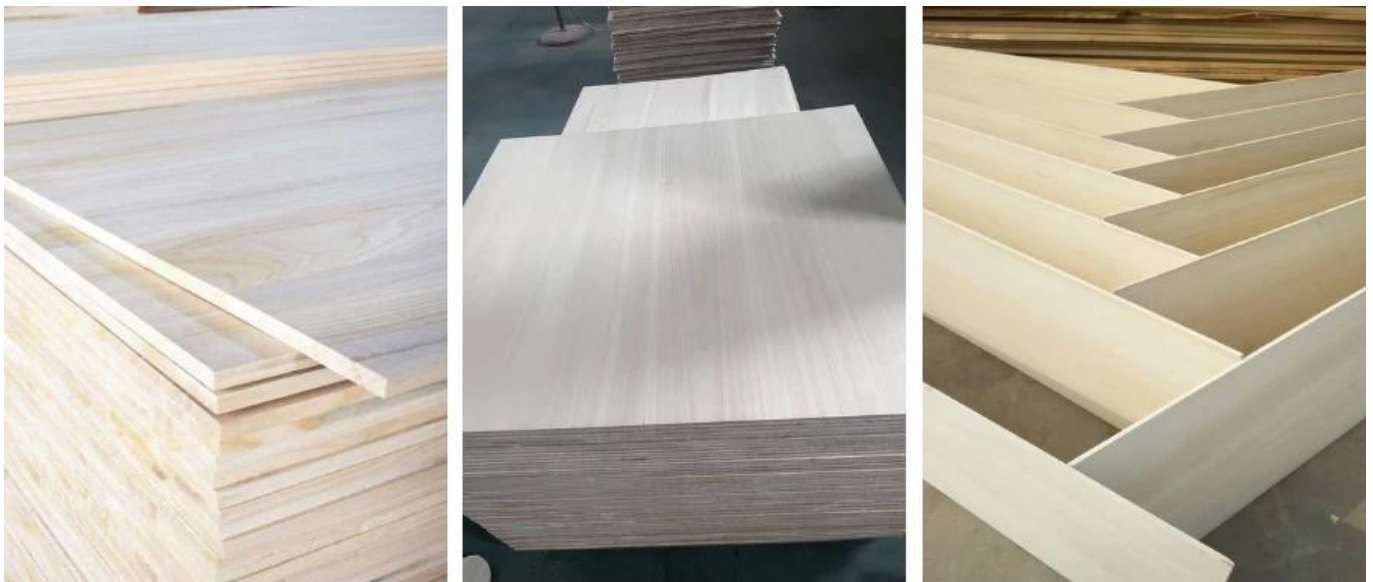


Faisnéis bhunúsach táirge

Ábhar amh: [Ardchaighdeán Paulownia Wood](#) roghnaítear é mar an t -amhábhar bunúsach. Fásann crann Paulownia go tapa, tá an t -ábhar éadrom agus bog, le feidhmíocht próiseála nádúrtha nádúrtha. Roghnaímid logaí Paulownia le grán díreach, fiú uigeacht, agus níl aon lochtanna soiléire cosúil le moth agus lobhadh chun bonn cáilíochta an táirge a chinntiú.

BLEACHING: Úsáidtear próiseas tuartha uathúil agus neamhdhíobhálach don chomhshaol chun caitheamh le hadhmad Paulownia. Cuireann an próiseas seo na líocha agus na heisíontais nádúrtha ar dhromchla Paulownia Wood go héifeachtach, agus coinníonn sé an bunstruchtúr agus airíonna fisiceacha an adhmaid a mhéid is féidir. Tar éis tuartha, cuireann Paulownia Wood dath aonfhoirmeach bán i láthair, a sholáthraíonn bonn maith do phróiseáil agus do chur i bhfeidhm ina dhiaidh sin.

Sonraíocht agus Méid: Is féidir linn sonraíochtaí éagsúla a chur ar fáil do tháirgí tuartha Paulownia de réir riachtanais na gcustaiméirí, agus áirítear le tiús coiteann na mbord ach 3mm, 5mm, 9mm, 12mm, 15mm, 18mm, srl.

Gnéithe Táirgí

Tá an t -ábhar éadrom agus bog: Tá Paulownia féin éadrom agus coinníonn sé an tréith seo fós tar éis cóireála tuartha. Fágann an t -ábhar éadrom agus bog go bhfuil an táirge níos áisiúla sa phróiseas láimhseála, próiseála agus suiteáil, ar féidir leis déine an tsaothair agus costais iompair a laghdú go héifeachtach.

Uigeacht álainn: an t -adhmaid tuartha Paulownia ([Bord Troscáin Paulownia tuartha](#)) a bhfuil uigeacht shoiléir nádúrtha aige, ag cur braistint uathúil áilleacht i láthair. Tá a grán díreach agus aonfhoirmeach, agus is féidir le tionchar maisiúil nádúrtha a chur le gach cineál táirgí, cibé acu a úsáidtear le haghaidh troscáin nó maisiú, stíl dhifriúil a thaispeáint.

Feidhmíocht Dea -Phróiseála: Tá feidhmíocht phróiseála maith ag Paulownia Wood, tá sé éasca le chonaic, pleanáil, druileáil agus oibríochtaí snoíodóireachta. Ní dhéanann cóireáil tuartha difear dá fheidhmíocht phróiseála bhunaidh, ach déanann sé dromchla an adhmaid níos réidh, níos fabhraí don phróiseáil ina dhiaidh sin, chun freastal ar riachtanais na bpróiseas éagsúil.

Cobhsaíocht ard: Tá feabhas breise tagtha ar chobhsaíocht thoiseach táirgí tuartha Paulownia trí phróiseas cóireála speisialta. I gcoinníollacha éagsúla taise agus teochta comhshaoil, níl sé éasca dífhoirmiúchán, scoilteadh agus fadhbanna eile, agus is féidir é a choinneáil ar feadh i bhfad i riocht maith.

Tá sé neamhdhiobhálach don chomhshaol agus sláintiúil: Tá an próiseas tuartha agus na ceimiceáin chóireála gaolmhara a úsáidimid ag teacht le caighdeáin chomhshaoil, chun a chinntiú go bhfuil an táirge neamhdhiobhálach do dhaoine agus don chomhshaol i dtáirgeadh agus úsáid an phróisis. Ag an am céanna, mar acmhainn in -athnuaite Paulownia Wood, ach ag teacht leis an gcoincheap forbartha inbhuanaithe.



Buntáistí Táirgí

Saincheapadh aonair: De réir riachtanais shonracha na gcustaiméirí, is féidir linn seirbhísí saincheaptha pearsantaithe a sholáthar ó mhéid an tsonraíochta go cóireáil dromchla agus mar sin de. Cibé an bhfuil sé ina riachtanais datha speisialta, éifeachtaí uigeachta, nó sonraíochtaí méid uathúil, is féidir linn ár ndícheall a dhéanamh bualadh leo agus táirgí uathúla a chruthú do chustaiméirí.

Dearbhú Cáilíochta: Leanaimid go docht na caighdeáin rialaithe cáilíochta i ngach céim ó cheannachán amhábhair go táirgeadh agus próiseáil. Le foireann iniúchta cáilíochta gairmiúla agus trealamh ard -tástála, déanaimid tástáil dhian ar tháscairí éagsúla na dtáirgí chun a chinntiú go gcomhlíonann gach táirge riachtanais ardchaighdeáin.

Éifeachtach ó thaobh costais de: I gcomparáid le roinnt táirgí adhmaid eile, tá feidhmíocht mhaith agus cuma álainn ag Paulownia tuartha, agus tá an praghas níos réasúnta. Laghdaíonn a ábhar

éadrom agus bog na costais próiseála agus iompair freisin, ionas gur féidir le custaiméirí táirgí ardchaighdeán a fháil ar chostas réasúnta íseal, le feidhmíocht ardchostais.

Réimsí iarratais

Déantúsaíocht troscáin: a úsáidtear go forleathan i dtáirgeadh cineálacha éagsúla troscáin, mar shampla wardrobes adhmaid soladach, deasca, táblaí itheacháin, cathaoireacha agus mar sin de. Tá sé éasca a ábhar éadrom agus bog a phróiseáil i gcruthanna éagsúla, agus is féidir le huigeacht álainn agus a dhath bán feabhas a chur ar cháilíocht fhoriomlán agus ar éifeacht mhaisiúil an troscáin.

Maisiú: Is féidir é a úsáid le haghaidh maisiú balla, uasteorainn, urláir agus mar sin de. Mar ábhar maisiúil, is féidir le tuaradh Paulownia atmaisféar te, nádúrtha agus simplí laistigh a chruthú, agus is féidir lena chobhsaíocht mhaith éifeacht mhaisiúil fhadtéarmach a chinntiú.

Ceardaíocht Táirgeadh: Mar gheall ar a thréithe próiseála agus snoíodóireachta éasca, is é an t-ábhar idéalach é chun gach cineál ceardaíochta a dhéanamh, mar shampla ornáidí snoíodóireachta adhmaid, frámaí grianghraf, boscaí seodra agus mar sin de. Féadann sé ceardaíocht bhreá agus charm ealaíonta uathúil a thaispeáint.

Tionscal Pacáistithe: Tá sé oiriúnach do gach cineál ábhar pacáistithe a dhéanamh, mar shampla boscaí, boscaí agus mar sin de. Ní hamháin gur féidir leis an ábhar éadrom agus bog na hearraí a chosaint, ach laghdaítear costas an phacáistithe freisin, ag an am céanna, tá sé éasca a fheidhmíocht phróiseála a tháirgeadh freisin éagsúlacht cruthanna agus sonraíochtaí táirgí pacáistithe a tháirgeadh.
